At Bloomingdale HS a student named Alex shared how he was moved around as a young boy until at 11 he was homeless! Then a friend told his own parents that Alex needed help. He moved in with this Christian family and later was adopted but did not trust the Lord until he was 16. His story was remarkable and encouraging to the other students as his life has proved the love that Jesus has for His children. At the conclusion of our meeting at Wiregrass Ranch HS our students were asked to reflect and pray for God's forgiveness and mercy. Then as student leaders, youth pastors and staff stood on the gym floor, students came forward for prayer. At the end of the meeting 45 had come forward. At Sunlake HS after 3 months of students praying and waiting we have been approved to begin Legacy Club. God is faithful and these are but a few of the moments where we saw this.
