I am going to share with you about one of the most significant Legacy Club meetings held this year. At Wiregrass Ranch HS in Wesley Chapel, the leaders completed the whole program themselves. It began with students standing in a "jail cell" looking very distraught. Once the 300 students were seated these 4 student gave monologues on their "addiction." Next a skit called "Lighthouse," then a student shared a dramatic testimony how he conquered his vices through Christ. The next part was a Bible message by one of our leaders on how to have victory in one's life. The students were then asked to write their sins that they wanted victory over and to walk through the jail and drop their sin notes there. More than 200 students walked through the jail. Here is one that was very touching. "I am going to change my ways and prove everyone wrong. I'm not what people think I am. I'm like everyone else, covered in sins because I'm not perfect but I'm going to change and become a better person through Jesus Christ!" Here are some of the other notes: addiction I want to break from; cursing, anger, lust, self esteem, partying, cutting, gossip, judging, disobeying my parents, lying, drugs, alcohol, etc, etc. These kids are transparent and needy. PTL!
