The Legacy Club

Webster's says **Legacy** is "something handed down from one who has gone before."

Our Mission: to equip next generation leaders through training in evangelism, discipleship, outreach and missions.

Our Vision: is to see our trained leaders take on future roles of leadership, and skillfully handle Scripture and their faith in Jesus Christ, leaving a legacy wherever they go.

Where do we form Legacy Clubs? The majority of Legacy Clubs begin in our public and private high schools. Each school has a Teacher Sponsor who helps organize and form the leadership team.

What does the Leadership Team do?

The leadership team meets at least twice a month to study the Scriptures. They address current issues and search the scriptures for answers. Once a month, they organize an outreach meeting for all other club members during club day.

Where do the clubs meet?

These meetings take place on campus during club day, or after school, or in the evening at someone's home.

What happens at a Discipleship Training?

The meetings center around major themes found in the Bible. For example; the life and teachings of the Son of God, Jesus Christ, the character and attributes of God, how to love God and how to love other people, major doctrines, and salvation. We can study the Bible in school! Praise the Lord!

What happens at an Outreach meeting?

These meetings focus on reaching other students for Christ. The student-led meetings have student worship bands, with testimonies and messages by the students. Occasionally, we would bring in a guest speaker. The training the leaders have learned is put into practice.

What else is happening?

Athletic chapels, service projects, coaches ministry, foreign missions, and prayer.
