It all began on October 1st 2007, and has been the biggest step of faith for us since 1987 when we began our ministry with FCA. It has very clear to us that *Zenon Ministries* is where the Lord wanted us to minister. The needs of our youth can only be met with relevant teaching of the Scriptures. To achieve this we have started weekly Legacy Clubs in our schools, teaching lessons from the Bible that are both spiritually deep and challenging.

Our goal is to teach them the techniques of sharing, explaining & defending their faith clearly, and conscisely .

The Work Continues ... Every Friday, I was given an opportunity to share a Biblical presentation to High School pregame chapel programs.

Sue and I were blessed to be a part of the **Migrant Workers Outreach at Wimauma**, with 200 Volunteers from Idlewild Baptist Church.

We ministered to 2000 migrant workers and their families. I was involved in evangelism, and was teamed up with a translator.



I was able to pray with around 42 during the morning & afternoon program.



Sue was doing face painting for the children, along with a team of artists, painting the faces of over 500 kids.
