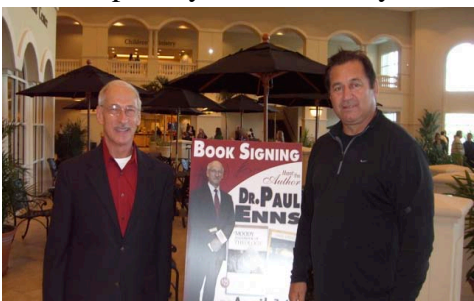
Greetings from Zenon Ministries!

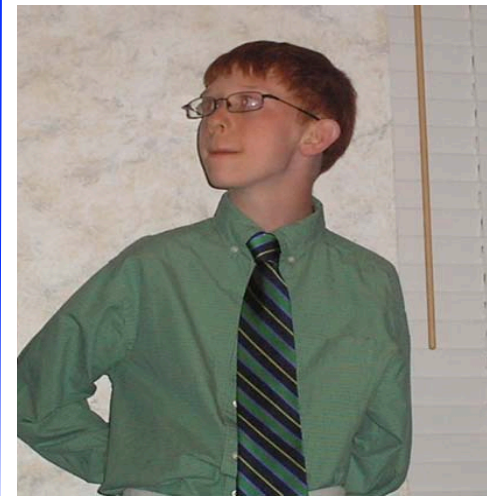


Words of Encouragement:
