Greetings ZM Friends,

A recent survey by Lifeway Research of "Millennials", those born between 1980-91 was extremely revealing. Two-thirds call themselves Christians, but fewer pray or read the Bible daily, attend worship services or hold to historical positions on the Bible and its teachings. Only 8% read the Bible on a daily basis, 67% rarely visit a church, 20% meet with a small group weekly, 53% disagree that the Bible is the written Word of God, only 31% believe that Jesus is the only path to heaven and 33% agree that no one knows for sure what will happen after we die. Overall, religion and its practices are decreasing and becoming increasingly privatized among this generation. This generation is the most diverse in our culture's history. There is a great opportunity to engage them with the nature of truth and its authority as God.
