Greetings ZM Friends,

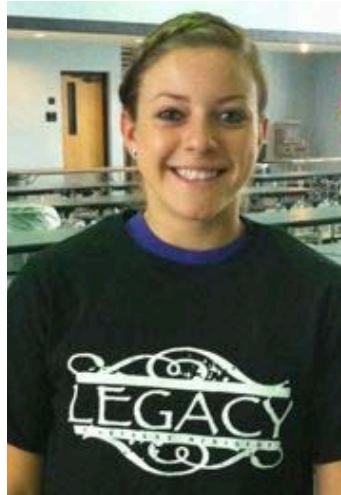

Topic: Trustworthiness

Opening Prayer and Welcome: by student
Worship Music: playing as students walk in to gym.
Bible Verse: Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight. Proverbs 3:5-6

Explanation: trustworthiness- true blue-loyalty

Skits: a number of skits by students depicting how loyalty has been lost and damaged. Student skits.

Some thoughts on Trust: a) Trust is the basis for every relationship. b) Your willingness to trust another person is important if you want that person to trust you. c) Being trustworthy will be a big part in the quality of your character.

Demonstrating Trustworthiness: ☺ Be honest ☺ Don't deceive, cheat, or steal ☺ Be reliable- do what you say you'll do ☺ Have the courage to do the right thing ☺ Build a good reputation ☺ Be loyal- stand by your family, friends, and country.

Living Video: Jesus walking on the Water. Students re enact the scene when Jesus walked on the water and encouraged Peter to also walk on water.

Reading Scripture: Jesus asks Peter to trust him.

Read: Matthew 14:22-32

Youth Pastor Message: from above scripture.

Close in prayer: Invite students to pray to trust Jesus Christ after meeting. Get info on each student.
